All hirers MUST bring their **LICENCE**, a **PROOF OF ADDRESS** and their **NATIONAL INSURANCE NUMBER**

Proof of address must be one of the following:

- Bank statement
- Post office or Building Society Savings Book
- Current Utility Bill (NOT mobile phone)

Drivers aged 21-22 must be free from endorsement

Drivers 23-24 acceptable if they do not disclose more than one minor conviction within the past 5 years

Drivers 25-75 are acceptable if, in the last 5 years, they have minor convictions which total 6 points or less

The following hirers are **unacceptable**:

- Persons under the age of 21 or over 75 years of age
- Persons who have held a full UK licence for less than 12 months (over 25) or 24 months (under 25)
- Persons whom have been convicted of any major crimes in the past 5 years
- Persons whom have had an insurance policy cancelled or refused
- Anyone who has a major conviction. This will show up on a licence check as one of the codes below.

Major Convictions:

Accident Offences:

AC10 – Failure to stop and/or give particulars after an accident

AC20 – Failure to give particulars or report an accident within 24 hours

AC30 – Undefined accident offence

MR19 – Wilful failure to carry out the obligation placed on driver after being involved in a road accident (hit and run)

Disqualified Driver Offences:

BA10 – Driving whilst disqualified by court

BA20 – Driving whilst disqualified by reason of age

BA30 – Attempting to drive whilst disqualified by court

BA40 – Causing death by driving whilst disqualified

BA60 – Causing serious injury by driving whilst disqualified

MR49 – Driving a vehicle whilst disqualified

MR59 – Other conduct constituting an offence for which a driving disqualification has been imposed by the State of Offence

NE99 – Non-endorsable offence for which you can be disqualified (criminal act etc.)

TT99 – Disqualification under 'totting-up' procedure

XX99 – Over three months disqualification under 'totting-up' procedure

Careless Driving Offences:

CD40 – Causing death by careless driving when unfit through drink

CD50 – Causing death by careless driving when unfit through drugs

CD60 – Causing death by careless driving with alcohol level above the limit

CD70 – Causing death by careless driving, then failing to supply a specimen for analysis

CD90 – Causing death by driving: unlicensed, disqualified or uninsured drivers

Insurance Offences:

IN10 – Using a vehicle uninsured against third party risks

Licensing Offences:

LC30 – Driving after making a false declaration about fitness when applying for a licence

LC40 – Driving a vehicle having failed to notify a disability

LC50 – Driving after a licence has been revoked or refused on medical grounds

Micellaneous Offences:

MS40 – Driving with uncorrected defective eyesight or refusing to submit to a test

MS50 – Motor racing on the highway

MS60 – Offences not covered by other codes

MS70 – Driving with uncorrected defective eyesight

MS90 – Failure to give information as to identity of driver etc.

Theft of Unauthorised Taking Offences:

UT10 – Taking or driving away a vehicle without consent or an attempt threat

UT20 – Stealing or attempting to steal a vehicle

UT30 – Going equipped for stealing or taking a vehicle

UT40 – Taking or attempting to take a vehicle without consent; allowing oneself to be carried in or on a vehicle knowing it to have been taken without consent

UT50 – Aggravated taking of a vehicle

Dangerous Driving Offences:

DD10 – Causing serious injury by dangerous driving

DD20 – Dangerous speed

DD30 – Reckless driving

DD40 – Dangerous driving

DD60 – Manslaughter or culpable homicide while driving a vehicle

DD70 – Causing death by reckless driving

DD80 – Causing death by dangerous driving

MR90 – Furious driving

MR09 – Reckless or dangerous driving (whether or not resulting in death, injury or serious risk)

Drink and Drug Offences:

DG10 – Driving or attempting to drive with drug level about the specified limit

DG40 – In charge of a vehicle while drug level above specified limit

DG60 – Causing death by careless driving with drug level above the limit

DR10 – Driving or attempting to drive with blood/alcohol level above the limit

DR20 – Driving or attempting to drive while unfit through drink

DR30 – Driving or attempting to drive then refusing to supply a specimen for analysis

DR40 – In charge of a vehicle while alcohol level above limit

DR50 – In charge of a vehicle while unfit through drink

DR60 – In charge of a vehicle then refusing to supply a specimen for analysis

DR70 – Failure to provide a specimen for breath test

DR80 – Driving or attempting to drive when unfit through drugs

DR90 – In charge of a vehicle when unfit through drugs

MR29 – Driving a vehicle under the influence of alcohol or other substance affecting or diminishing the mental and physical abilities of a driver

Minor Convictions

Construction and Use Offences:

CU10 – Using a vehicle with defective brakes

CU20 – Using vehicle with oarts or accessories in a dangerous condition

CU30 – Using a vehicle with defective tyres

CU40 – Using a vehicle with defective steering

CU50 – Causing or likely to cause danger by reason of load of passengers

CU60 – Undefined failure to comply with construction and use regulations

CU80 – Breach of requirements as to control of the vehicle, such as using a mobile phone

Careless Driving Offences:

CD10 – Driving without due care and attention

CD20 – Driving without reasonable consideration for other road users

CD30 – Driving without due care and attention or without reasonable consideration for other road users

Licensing Offences:

LC10 – Driving without a licence

LC20 – Driving otherwise than in accordance with a licence

Miscellaneous Offences:

MS10 – Leaving a vehicle in a dangerous position

MS20 – Unlawful pillion riding

MS30 – Playstreet offences

Motorway Offences:

MW10 – Contravention of special road regulations (excluding speed limits)

Pedestrian Crossing Offences:

PC10 – Undefined contravention of pedestrian crossing regulations

PC20 – Contravention of pedestrian crossing regulations with moving vehicle

PC30 – Contravention of pedestrian crossing regulations with stationary vehicle

Provisional Licence Offences:

PL10 – Driving without 'L' plates

PL20 – Not accompanied by a qualified person

MR39 – Driving vehicle faster than the permitted speed

SP10 – Exceeding goods vehicle speed limit

SP20 – Exceeding speed limit for type of vehicle

SP30 – Exceeding statutory speed limit on a public road

SP40 – Exceeding passenger vehicle speed limit

SP50 – Exceeding speed limit on a motorway

SP60 – Undefined speed limit offence

Traffic Direction and Sign Offences:

TS10 – Failing to comply with traffic light signals

Foreign Use

The Certificate of Insurance issued to you provides evidence of full policy cover whilst travelling in the following territories:

Directive on insurance of civil liabilities arising from the use of motor vehicles (No.72/166/CEE)

Outside the UK, full insurance cover for any other EU country and Norway, Switzerland, Liechtenstein and Iceland is available as follows:

For any trip up to 15 days outside Great Britain, Northern Ireland, The Isle of Man or The Channel Islands, an additional £25 will apply. All such trips must be recorded and declared along with the business turnover on the Foreign Use form supplied by Allianz.

Any trips of 16-30 days must be referred, and will be subject to an appropriate additional charge.

Trips of 30 days or more are unacceptable.
